

Recycling Center

Citizens may deposit recyclable items—aluminum, paper, plastic and cardboard—in a transfer trailer located at 122 Ridgewood Road. This site is open Wednesday–Saturday from 8am –to 5pm. Household garbage should not be mixed in with recyclables or with yard debris.

Trash/debris can be dropped off only on Saturdays during Recycling Center hours. City residents need to bring a current water bill to avoid charges. No large appliance, tires, furniture will be accepted.



Trash Collection Schedule



Household Garbage

The City of Prattville Sanitation Department provides household garbage collection twice weekly. Garbage is defined as household foodstuff, paper etc. Have garbage out no earlier than 7:00 am on your scheduled days. Do not put garbage out before the scheduled day of pickup.

Residential Trash

Residential trash is collected once a week for the City of Prattville. Trash is defined as limbs, leaves, grass clippings, boxes, etc. Each neighborhood is completed on the schedule before trucks move on to another.

Holiday Policy

If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the City will observe it on Friday. If the holiday falls on a Sunday, the City will observe it on Monday. Routes not collected due to holidays will be picked up the next business day along with the routes for that day. All routes will be collected the day after Thanksgiving and Christmas.

City of Prattville Ordinances

- It is unlawful to throw, sweep, or otherwise deposit garbage or rubbish in any sewer, gutter, or drainage way, or upon any curb, street, sidewalk, or vacant lot. Violators are subject to arrest.
- Leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, etc. must be bagged between April 15th –October 1st.
- Limbs and hedge clippings must be no larger than 8 inches in diameter or 4 feet long. Stack in an orderly fashion near the curb, but not in the street, gutter or on the sidewalk. Avoid placing by a mailbox, utility pole, or anything that will obstruct the use of equipment. No stumps or tree trunks will be picked up.
- Debris left by tree surgeons, pulp woodcutters, landscape companies, roofers, construction workers, etc. will not be picked up. **Those professionals must also have a current city business license operate.**
- No paints, batteries, oil etc., or hazardous materials will be collected. Building materials, bricks, concrete, dirt, lumber, etc. will also not be picked up.

City of Prattville Ordinances

- Curbside pickup of excessive amounts of trash or other items such as appliances and furniture require a fee, payable in advance, and scheduled by Sanitation Department Director, Edward Clinton. He is reachable Monday–Friday 8:00am–5:00 pm at 334-361-3611.
- Boxes must be broken down, if possible, or smaller boxes placed within larger ones. All plastic or paper packing materials must be placed in a box or taped to prevent scattering.

General Information

- ◇ Charges for Sanitation services will be included on your monthly water bill.
- ◇ Do not mix garbage with trash. Different trucks are used to pick up garbage vs. trash.
- ◇ Place all garbage in plastic bags. Do not place garbage in cans, boxes, or other containers, even if it is bagged.
- ◇ For safety, do not put loose, broken glass or any sharp objects in the bags. Enclose these items in a box or other rigid container before placing them in with other trash.
