Recycling Center

Citizens may take recyclable items to the recycling center located at 122 Ridgewood Road. Bagged Household garbage and Trash (yard debris) may be dropped off only on Saturdays during Recycling Center hours. City residents need to bring a current water bill to avoid charges. No bulk waste items will be accepted. Recycling bins have been placed in the parking lot of Overlook Memorial Park, 229 Jay Street. These bins are open to the public during daylight hours every day of the week. Citizens may drop off paper, cardboard, aluminum, steel or tin cans, and plastic with recycling codes 1 and 2.

Important Information

It is unlawful to throw, sweep, or otherwise deposit garbage or rubbish in any sewer, gutter, drainage way, or upon any curb, street, sidewalk or vacant lot. Violators are subject to arrest.

Garbage

Garbage is considered any household item such as food waste, bathroom articles, paper, pet waste, etc.

Bagged Garbage routes are run Monday through Friday and are picked up on either a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday schedules. Garbage can routes are listed on the Garbage Can Zone Map.

Bagged garbage or garbage cans should be placed on the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled day of pick-up. Please do not put garbage out the night before the scheduled day of pick-up.

Do not mix garbage with trash. Different trucks are used to pick up various items.


Place all garbage in plastic bags. Residents with garbage cans must have all garbage in the can and adhere to the rules listed on the top of the garbage can.

Charges for Sanitation services will be included on your monthly water bill.


No batteries, oil, tires, or other hazardous materials will be picked up.

For safety, do not put loose, broken glass or any other sharp objects in the bags. Enclose these items in a box or other rigid container before placing them in with other garbage collection.


Garbage Zone Map

Trash (Yard Debris)

Trash is considered to be limbs, leaves, grass clippings, boxes, etc. and will be picked up one time per week in each neighborhood.

Leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, etc. must be bagged between April 15th and October 1st. Limbs and hedge clippings must be no larger than 8 in. diameter or 4 ft. long.

Curbside pickup of large amounts of trash (yard debris) or other bulk items require a **special collection**. For bulk waste (Construction debris, mattresses, appliances, etc.) a **collection charge** will be assessed based on the current rate of disposal. This rate will be determined annually by the Director of Public Works. Where the quantity collected is less than a truck load, the collection charge will be prorated. Please contact the Sanitation Division at (334) 595-0888 to schedule a special collection.

Boxes must be broken down if possible, or smaller boxes placed within larger ones. All plastic or paper packing materials must be placed in a box and taped to prevent scattering. Stack in an orderly fashion near the curb, but not in the street, gutter or on the sidewalk. Avoid placing by a mailbox, utility pole or anything that will obstruct the use of equipment. No stumps or tree trunks will be picked up.

Debris left by tree surgeons, pulp woodcutters, roofers, construction workers, etc. will not be collected. A current City business license is required by these business owners in order to perform services in the City of Prattville.
