**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE "AUTAUGA COUNTY, ALABAMA, NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN" IN INACCORDANCE WITH THE CRITERIA OF THE FEDERAL DISASTER MITIGATION ACT OF 2000**

**WHEREAS**, The Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000), as administered by the Alabama Emergency Management Agency (AEMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires the development and adoption of a local natural hazards mitigation plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, DMA 2000 as a condition for qualifying for certain Federal disaster assistance programs requires the adoption of local natural hazard mitigation plan, and

**WHEREAS**, DMA 2000 provides Federal assistance to local governments to relieve damage from disasters, to encourage disaster preparedness planning and programs, to coordinate response efforts and to implement hazard mitigation measures; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Autauga County Hazard Mitigation Committee developed, and FEMA approved the local natural hazard mitigation plan in 2005; and,

**WHEREAS**, DMA 2000 requires the Autauga County Emergency Management Agency to update the local natural hazard mitigation plan every 5 years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the "Autauga County, Alabama, Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan" has been updated and prepared in accordance with DMA 2000 requirements to include Autauga County, the City of Prattville, and the Towns of Autaugaville and Billingsley; and,

**WHEREAS**, "Autauga County, Alabama, Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan" addresses all natural hazards deemed to threaten the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Autauga County, Alabama;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRATTVILLE CITY COUNCIL**, that the "Autauga County, Alabama, Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan" is hereby adopted and immediately made effective.
