35 and determined that the public nuisance still exists; and

WHEREAS, §11-53B-1 through §11-53B-16 *Code of Alabama, 1975*, as amended,
Details the process for the City of Prattville to declare certain unsafe structures a public
nuisance and order their repair or demolition; and

WHEREAS, §11-53B-3 *Code of Alabama, 1975* as amended requires that the City’s
order to repair or demolish an unsafe structure be sent to the owner of the property and those
having legal interest in the property; and

WHEREAS, §11-53B-3 and §11-53B-4 *Code of Alabama, 1975*, as amended requires
the owners to repair or demolish the unsafe structure within forty-five (45) days of being
issued an order from the city or to request a hearing before the City Council of the City of
Prattville within thirty (30) days of the order; and

WHEREAS, §11-53B-3 *Code of Alabama, 1975*, as amended permits the City of
Prattville to repair or demolish an unsafe structure if the owner fails to comply with the city
order; and

WHEREAS, §11-53B-5 *Code of Alabama, 1975*, as amended permits the City Council
of the City of Prattville to adopt a resolution affixing the cost of demolition and establishing a
lien against the property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Council of the City of Prattville finds that:

1. The City of Prattville’s Code Enforcement Officer and its Building Official have declared the residential structure at 1159 Old Highway 31 to be a dilapidated structure on March 20, 2015,
2. The Code Enforcement Officer issued an order to T. L. Thaggard on March 20, 2015, to have the property repaired or demolished within forty-five (45) days of the notice,
3. T. L. Thaggard did not request a hearing before the City Council within thirty (30) days of the notice nor repair or demolish the structure within forty-five (45) days of the notice,
4. The City Council declared the structure located at 1159 Old Highway 31 to be unsafe and a public nuisance in Resolution Book 2015, Page 040,
5. The City Council authorized the demolition of the structure and awarded the contract complete demolition in Resolution Book 2015, Page 051.
6. The Code Enforcement Division of the Prattville Police Department has determined the total cost of demolition to be \$4,175.44 and presented such to the City Council of the City of Prattville (Attachment “A”).
