WHEREAS, sealed bids were let for Bid No. 015-010 for one or more Turnout Coat, Turnout Pant, and Suspender, or equivalent, pursuant to the general competitive bid law, Sections 41-16-50 *et seq.*, *Code of Alabama*, 1975, as amended; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received, opened and read in public on November 9, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Emergency Services Inc. was the lowest bidder; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Terry Brown recommends that the bid received from Municipal Emergency Services Inc. be rejected because of failure to meet the following specific bid requirements:

- **Section 1.10:** A stock of common sizes of the gear proposed will be kept in a location where it can be readily shipped, and gear will be shipped within 24 hours of placing the order.
- **Section 3.7:** Moisture barrier will be nonwoven aramid substrate laminated to a light weight breathable, Gore RT7100™ PTFE, membrane.
- **Section 3.7:** Moisture barrier liner will be completely detachable from the outer shell by the use of hook and loop zippers and snaps.
- **Section 3.13:** The elbow will be reinforced by gold split cowhide leather for abrasion resistance and thermal protection.
- **Section 3.14:** The cuff sleeve will be reinforced with a binding of gold split cowhide leather.
- **Section 3.17:** The front closure will consist if a thermoplastic zipper.
- **Section 4.2:** Moisture barrier will be nonwoven aramid substrate laminated to a light weight breathable, Gore RT7100™ PTFE, membrane.
- **Section 4.4:** The pants closure will be provided by a thermoplastic zipper.
- **Section 4.6:** The knee will be gold split cowhide leather and measure 9” across the bottom, not less than 7” on the sides and gradually increase to 12” at the center point at the apex.
- **Section 4.7:** The cuff area of the pants will be reinforced with a binding of gold split cowhide leather not less than 2” in total width.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Prattville, Alabama, that the bid received from Municipal Emergency Services Inc. on Bid No. 015-010 is hereby rejected.
