Miss Fountain City, Jessica Brookshire, will speak about her platform K.A.R.M.A.- Kids Against Ridicule, Meanness and Aggression. The goal of this platform is to stop bullying through education and awareness. She will speak about her life experiences that led her to be an advocate of bullying.

42% of kids have been bullied while online. 1 in 4 kids have had it happen more than once. Girls are twice as likely as boys to be victims and perpetrators. Cyber bullying is most prevalent among 15 and 16 year olds. Cyber bullying includes email, instant message and text messages.
