WHEREAS, the descendants of the Robert and Tillie Stoudemire will hold their family reunion May 26-28, 2012 in Prattville, Alabama.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Gillespie Jr., Mayor of the City of Prattville hereby commend the
