



# Proclamation

## By the Mayor of Prattville, Alabama

*WHEREAS*, the government of Prattville, Alabama celebrates our local small businesses and the contributions they make to our local economy and community; and

*WHEREAS*, according to the United States Small Business Administration, there are currently 28.8 million small businesses in the United States and they represent more than 99.7 percent of American employer firms, create more than two-thirds of the net new jobs, and generate 50 percent of private gross domestic product, as well as 54 percent of all US sales. Small businesses employ over 50 percent of the working population in the United States; and

*WHEREAS*, 89 percent of consumers in the United States agree that small businesses contribute positively to the local community by supplying jobs and generating tax revenue; and

*WHEREAS*, 87 percent of consumers in the United States agree that small businesses are critical to the overall economic health of the United States; and

*WHEREAS*, 93 percent of consumers in the United States agree that it is important for people to support the small businesses that they value in their community; and

*WHEREAS*, we encourage citizens to consider shopping small merchants on Small Business Saturday as a way to boost the local economy and strengthen our small business community. Small Business Saturday is a nationwide campaign to promote awareness of our small merchants on the Saturday after Thanksgiving; and

*WHEREAS*, Small Business Saturday will stimulate economic growth locally for small merchants by following in the tradition of Black Friday and Cyber Monday, two of the busiest shopping days of the year.

*NOW THEREFORE*, I, Bill Gillespie Jr., Mayor of the City of Prattville, Alabama, do hereby recognize November 25, 2017 as
